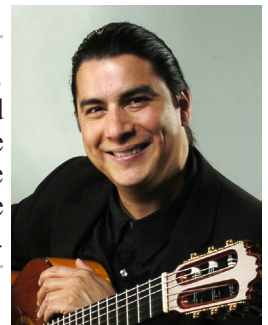


Billie Dean, November 10, 2011
